7:00 – 8:30 pm Tango Level I

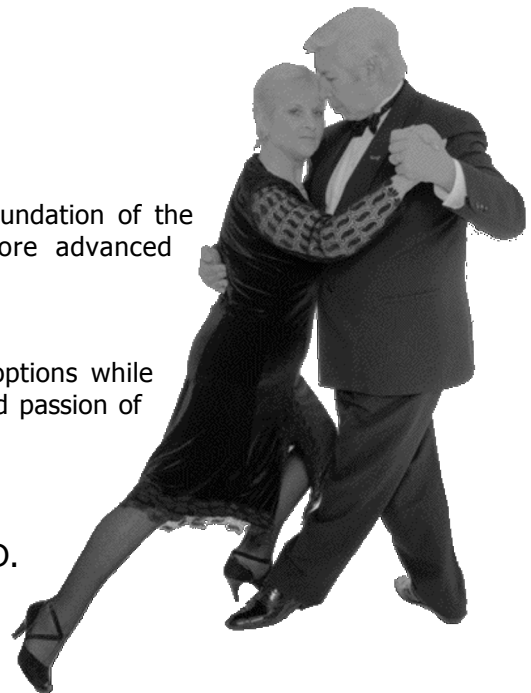
Fundamentals of movement and partnership – the foundation of the dance. Mastery of these fundamentals makes more advanced elements and combinations possible.
